We had a very good meeting with the Residents this morning and were encouraged by the good questions and feelings amongst the group. Here are the highlights of the meeting:

#### Resident Checks

- Starting at 8:00am Wednesday, a staff member will visit each unit to:
  - Confirm who is staying in the unit
  - Confirm the resident-selected Safe Place (corridor hallway, or non-windowed space within the unit) for each resident.
  - Assist with moving a comfortable chair to the Safe Place.
  - Check that Unit windows are closed.
  - Note any other resident concerns.
  - Collect dining information for Wednesday and Thursday meal service
- Staff will continue these Resident Checks until the storm event is over

#### Dining

- Dinner will be served in the Dining Room tonight, Tuesday, September 27<sup>th</sup>
- Wednesday and Thursday lunch and dinner will be take-out or delivery only. The limited menu will be the same for both days and collected through the Resident Checks.
- There will be limited Continental Breakfast Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday in the Lounge. While we received a food delivery today, we do not expect another until Saturday. We ask that everyone please take only what they need.
- Coffee and water will be available in the Lounge throughout Wednesday and Thursday.

#### Resident Guests and Staff Sheltering at SBC

- All resident guests and staff must check in with the North Tower front desk after 5:00pm tonight (Tuesday, September 27<sup>th</sup>) and will receive a green wrist band. We will ask for the names and contact numbers of all guests and staff.
- All resident guests and staff should arrive by 7:00am Wednesday, September 28<sup>th</sup>.
- The South Tower Front Doors will be locked and secured Tuesday night, September 27<sup>th</sup>.

#### Emergency Pull Cords

- The Emergency Pull Cords are supported by the Emergency Generator.
